As the area's premier no-kill shelter, the Humane Society of Sarasota County leads the pack in animal welfare. Founded in 1952, HSSC was the first nonprofit animal welfare organization in Sarasota, and we have not slowed down since. Back then, we had room for 48 dogs and just 6 cats. Now, with the opening of our brand-new facility in 2021, we can care for and find permanent homes for 2,700 animals a year.

Our programs are guided by our mission to engage the hearts, hands, and minds of the community to help animals. From humane education and pet therapy to obedience courses and an affordable public veterinary clinic, HSSC is a resource for animals and the people who love them. We have earned the coveted 4-star rating from Charity Navigator, and we are the only animal welfare organization in Florida to have a perfect score.

We do all this without government or national funding. We are a private, local nonprofit that is not affiliated with any other humane organization. We rely on animal lovers—people like you—to help us turn our vision of a community where all animals are cared for and loved into a reality.
